## Criminal Justice/ Legal and Protective Services Careers

Criminal Justice/Legal and Protective Services is a three term program in which students must meet specific standards in each course in order to progress to the next term. The program focuses on the police, courts, and corrections.

This course seeks students of outstanding character who desire a career with the criminal justice system. The program will prepare students for entry level positions in police and corrections areas as well as preparing them for post-secondary education.

Guest speakers frequent the classroom and local field trips are used in order to allow students to observe different career areas The Criminal Justice/Legal and Protective Services class integrates science, mathematics, English, and Spanish to meet the community's needs.

Students who successfully complete the three term program are better prepared to seek employment and/or pursue higher education. Articulation with Walters State Community College for 6 credit hours is available.
