Fundraiser Updates

Our GSIA Fall Fundraiser will continue through September 29. This year orders can be placed on line at www.innisbrook.com. All instructions for registering students for prize credits and placing orders are on the sheet with the Disney Vacation information which was sent home with each child's fundraising packet. Tusculum View's school number, information for placing orders on line, and even information on how out of town friends and family can order is in this letter. **When you complete your order on line, you must print the voucher, and return the voucher and payment to the school in the Money Collection Envelope. ALL money for this fundraiser is to be collected when sold and turned in with the order voucher by September 29.** Once your child is registered, you can see if you are an Instant Winner! Students are also eligible for great school prizes. The prizes for the top three sellers (most items sold) at our school will be a

Nintendo DS, an I-Pod Shuffle, and a portable DVD player. If you do not have access to a computer, send completed order forms and

complete payment to school and GSIA volunteers will enter your order for you.
